SUBJECT: PROTEST LETTER SENIOR TRANSPORTATION SERVICES PROGRAM GRANT COMPETITION

Dear Mr. Thompson:

On April 18, 2013, RWD Consulting, LLC submitted an application in accordance to the requirements set forth in the Request for Application (RFA) for the DC Office on Aging (DCOA), Senior Transportation Services project. On May 13, 2013 the Senior Transportation RFA was re-issued; indicating the information and format remain unchanged. On June 10, 2013 RWD re-submitted an application in response to the re-issued RFA.

On August 26, 2013 we received a letter indicating that our application was not selected [disqualified or rejected] for the following reason(s):

- DCOA submitted all applications to a process of review by individuals selected by DCOA who were external to the DCOA, and had experience in the areas of aging and transportation. The application from RWD received an average score of 34 points out of a possible 100 points.

The purpose of this letter, in accordance to the conditions set forth in the RFA, is to protest the disqualification of our application by providing evidence that:

- Per DCMR 403-Section 1 DC government failed to follow the evaluation scheme outlined in the RFA. In failing to follow the evaluation scheme, RWD's score was greatly reduced. Therefore, RWD would like to receive a side-by-side comparison of how we scored against the awardee (s). In addition, Per DCMR 27-Section 304, RWD is requesting an automatic stay be put into effect.
