



The Department of Aging and Community Living's **Safe at Home** program makes homes and communities safer for District residents, age 60 and over, and adults with disabilities.

**Safe at Home** provides in-home preventative adaptations to reduce the risk of falls, such as:

- Handrails
- Grab bars
- Bathtub cuts
- Shower seats
- Furniture risers
- Chair lifts

**Safe at Home** provides eligible income qualifying residents with a private security camera system at no cost to them.
