## What is Safe at Home?

The Safe at Home program from the District of Columbia Office on Aging provides home safety and home security adaptations for qualifying seniors and adults with disabilities.

## It's Home Safety:

Safe at Home provides in-home preventative adaptations to reduce the risk of falls, such as:

- ◇ Handrails
- ◇ Grab bars
- ◇ Bathtub cuts
- ◇ Shower seats
- ◇ Furniture risers
- ◇ Chair lifts

## It's Home Security:
