All applicants must show evidence of staffing that includes a full-time Project Director, a licensed nutritionist/registered dietician, licensed social workers, ADRC **coordinator** for 18-59 year olds with disabilities, a community planner, and nutrition site managers, supported by other administrative staff, consultants and volunteers.
