Pursuant to DC law and the Freedom Of Information Act, 5 USC 552, and the Privacy Act of 1974, 5 USC 552a, I hereby request copies of the following documents.

If for

any reason you chose not to send me any of the documents or papers requested then please furnish me with a timely explanation.

I am requesting:

Copies of all videos produced by the agency or its contractors (on behalf of the agency) including videos produced for internal usage in 2012 and 2013?

In the event that some of the material is considered by you to be exempt from disclosure under both Acts, then please include all segregable portions of documents and the specific exemption you are relying upon to deny disclosure of the excised portions. Please note that in order to avoid disclosure you must claim an appropriate exemption under both Acts.

I am requesting that you abide by the statutory time within which to make a determination on this request, that being twenty (20) working days from your receipt under Section 552(a) (6)(A)(i).

I'm willing to pay any and all fees involved in the processing of this request, up to a limit of \$15.

A compelling need exists to warrant expedited processing of this request, because a large number of our viewers are immediately impacted by the content of these records. These records relate directly to performance of government in matters of safety, health and well-being. These records also pertain to issues involving widespread media reporting in recent months. Delayed processing jeopardizes

important, timely dissemination of information to the public.

Please provide records in electronic format.
